Helmut Butzkueven (MBBS 1992, PhD 2002), is an academic neurologist specializing in management of Multiple Sclerosis and real-world MS outcomes research. In 2015, he was appointed as a Professorial Fellow in the Department of Medicine, University of Melbourne.

He is Deputy director of the Melbourne Brain Centre (2011), and director of the MS services at Box Hill Hospital (since 2002) and the Royal Melbourne Hospital (since 2008).

Dr Butzkueven is the Managing Director of the MSBase Foundation (www.msbase.org), a global online MS cohort study which commenced in 2004, with more than 49,000 patients enrolled (215 centres, 27 countries), and more than 230,000 years of patient follow-up. Key current projects conducted by the MSBase research team include the use of registry data to compare treatment outcomes, assessment and refinement of detection of disability progression and secondary progressive MS, long-term treatment response prediction and MS treatment optimization including drug safety..
