

## Rogier Hintzen

Rogier Hintzen is Professor in MS and CNS neuroimmunology at Erasmus University and head of the MS Center ErasMS, Erasmus MC Rotterdam, The Netherlands.

His current research interests focus around biological determinants of the cause and the course of MS, including prediction of MS after a first attack, genes and environmental factors involved in MS and NMO, and cellular immunology of CNS inflammation. He supervises ongoing local and international studies on biomarkers in cerebrospinal fluid using several proteomic techniques.

He is chair of the scientific committee of the Dutch Society for Neurology and (board) member of the European School for Neuroimmunology (ESNI), the International Pediatric MS study Group (IPMSSG), the International Society for Neuroimmunology (ISNI) and the International MS Genetics Consortium (IMSGC).
