

Jean Pelletier is Professor in Neurology and he is currently the head of the Department of Neurology at the Timone University Hospital and of the multiple sclerosis (MS) Clinics in Marseilles, France. He is also the Scientific Director of the MS research team in the CRMBM CNRS7339 laboratory, president of the PACA Regional MS Network and president of the scientific OFSEP committee (National MS Observatoire). Jean Pelletier was trained in the Lyon Medical School and awarded his MD in Neurology and his PhD in Neurosciences by the University of Marseilles. He completed his neurological and scientific training in Paris (Salpêtrière Hospital) and in Boston (Harvard Medical School). The principal scientific interests of the team directed by Jean Pelletier are focused on markers of disease evolution (especially in cognition), development of new drugs and validation of new non conventional magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) techniques in MS. Jean Pelletier's group is also involved in French and international networks devoted to genetics, immunology and neuropsychology of MS. He has been Principal Investigator or National French Coordinator for more than 60 MS clinical trials and he is currently a member of Steering Committees and Advisory Boards for several international MS trials. He is also involved in numerous neurological and MS French and international Societies. He has published more than 200 original articles, reviews and book chapters, mostly in the area of MS.
