

Dr. Wolinsky is Professor Emeritus in Neurology, McGovern Medical School, UTHealth Houston. There he held the Bartels Family and Opal C. Rankin Professorships, directed the MS Research Group and MRI Analysis Center there until he retired last fall. He received his MD from University of Illinois (Chicago 1969). Residency in clinical neurology, fellowship in experimental neuropathology and first faculty appointment at UCSF followed. He joined the faculties of Johns Hopkins University in 1978. Since arriving in Houston (1983), his focus shifted to the design, implementation, conduct and analysis of clinical trials of MS, and basic and applied research in quantitative MRI analysis. He has served on review/advisory committees of the NIH, FDA, pharma and as interim Dean and interim Chair of Neurology at UTHealth. He was past chair of the Research Programs and National Medical Advisory Committees of the NMSS and President of ACTRIMS. He served on editorial boards of *MSJ* (1994-2017) and *MSARD* (inception – present) among others, Distinguished Physician of Memorial Hermann Hospital–TMC, Fellow AAN, AAN and AAAS, and Emeritus ASCI. He authored over 300 papers relevant to neurovirology, neuroimmunology, clinical trials and MS imaging.
