

Olga Ciccarelli has been Professor of Neurology at University College London's (UCL) Institute of Neurology, London, UK, since 2014. She studied at the University of Rome, Italy, completing her specialist training in Neurology in 1999. In 2005, she was awarded a PhD in Neurological Science at the UCL Institute of Neurology, and was subsequently awarded a Wellcome Trust Advanced Clinical Fellowship. Olga is Head of the multidisciplinary NMR (nuclear magnetic resonance) Research Unit, Queen Square MS Centre, at the UCL Institute of Neurology, and she runs specialist MS and general neurology outpatient clinics. Her main research interest is the investigation of mechanisms of damage and repair in MS using advanced imaging. She has secured funding from research councils and charities for her work, and has authored more than 160 papers in her research field (H Index 42). She supervises postgraduate PhD students and is involved in clinical teaching. She is Associate Editor of *Neurology*, leading on the *Neuroimmunology*, *Neuroinfection*, and *Neurovirology* portfolio.
