

Emmanuelle Le Page is a neurologist that is strongly involved in Rennes's clinical research programme on Multiple sclerosis, working closely with Gilles Edan. She has a great experience in the field of MS therapeutic research. She published papers on treating aggressive forms of MS, more specifically with mitoxantrone and with alemtuzumab after a stay in 2002 as a research fellow in Alastair Compston's team in Cambridge. She is also interested in treating relapses of MS with corticosteroids, published the COPOUSEP trial in 2015, demonstrating the possibility to treat relapses of MS orally rather than intravenously and continues to work on this topic.
