

Prof LIBLAU is Neurologist, specialized in inflammatory diseases of the CNS.

He performed his medical studies and training as neurologist in Paris, France. He then spent a 3-years post-doctoral training at Stanford University, USA working on experimental models of immunopathology.

Back to France he worked at the Salpêtrière Hospital (head of the CSF laboratory) and then moved to Toulouse as Professor of Clinical Immunology. His focus remains on CNS inflammatory diseases from MS to rare entities such as paraneoplastic neurological diseases, narcolepsy and Susac syndrome.

He is heading an Inserm - CNRS - University research institute devoted to the study of inflammatory, immunological, and infectious diseases (www.cptp.inserm.fr)
